

Admission Source (claims)

Institutional Admission

 Acute or Post-Acute Stay in the last 14 days





Community Admission

- No inpatient stay in the last 14 days
- Ex: Physician office referral



Your software most likely uses your answer to M1000.







Episode Timing (claims)



- Early = First 30-day period or if there is greater than 60 days between episodes
- Late = Anything not in the first 30-day period



Based off Primary Diagnosis on Claim!





- High or median resource use in a 30-day period of care
- Changes for CY2024 based on CY2022 home health data
- 22 Low adjustment subgroups a list of diagnoses with representing higher resource use.
- 102 High Interaction adjustments subgroups for diagnoses that use more resources together than apart.




