PASRR Technical Assistance Call (PTAC) – Jan. 17, 2018, 11:00am CT

This webinar discusses recent changes made to Interdisciplinary Team (IDT) Meeting requirements for nursing facility (NF) residents deemed PASRR positive following a CHOW or when an individual is enrolled in Hospice.

IDTS FOLLOWING A CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP (CHOW):

- **Current process:** When the NF has been assigned a new contract/provider number following a CHOW, if a resident has a confirmed positive PASRR Evaluation (PE), a new IDT meeting is not required.
- **New process:** When the NF has been assigned a new contract/provider number following a CHOW, if a resident has a confirmed positive PE, **a new IDT meeting is required.**

Effective Date of This Change: January 1, 2018

If a CHOW occurred before this date, and an IDT meeting was not conducted and submitted after the new PL1 and positive PE were entered, then an IDT meeting needs to be convened and submitted on the new PASRR Level One (PL1) to ensure it is documented on the Long-Term Care (LTC) Online Portal before December 31, 2018.

IDTS FOR PASRR POSITIVE INDIVIDUALS ENROLLED IN HOSPICE:

- **Current process:** When a positive PE for a NF resident enrolled in Hospice is submitted, an IDT meeting is not required and PASRR specialized services are not recommended.

New process: When a positive PE is submitted for a NF resident enrolled in Hospice **an IDT meeting is required and PASRR specialized services should be reviewed to determine on a case by case basis what services the individual can benefit from.**

Effective Date of This Change: January 1, 2018

A review should be completed and an IDT meeting held for individuals who are PASRR positive and were enrolled in Hospice before January 1, 2018. Ensure all the IDTs meetings are submitted on the LTC Online Portal prior to December 31, 2018.
