




#### **Breaking Down the "Excessively Low Weekend Staffing" Flag**

- Indicated on the 1705D CMS Report (Triggered or Not Triggered)
- Bottom 20% of facilities of the state
- Uses an Adjusted HRD calculation
- Is a "Total Nursing" calculation RNs + LVN/LPNs + CNAs
- If flagged, a nursing home will be at risk for a potential audit

## Tips for Lowering Your Turnover Rate

- Keep the same EmployeeIDs for staff every quarter
- Submit an EmployeeID Linking File every quarter, if needed
- In general, use in-house staffing when possible
- Ensure accuracy of data
- Always, always, always get your PBJ file submitted on time!

## **Latest Industry Trends**

#### What we're hearing from around the industry:

PDPM Case-Mix continues to be a challenge to predict with accustomed accuracy.

The new MFA requirement at QIES.net requires more connection time when submitting your file – don't wait for the last minute to submit!

PBJ audits and surveys are even more common than ever.



## The Census Report Moves to iQIES

#### A small but mighty change.

CMS moved the MDS census report from QIES.net to iQIES on July 14th.

SimplePBJ has rolled out a way to connect to the new data point.

For SimplePBJ-only subscribers, **getting linked in iQIES will now be required in order to pull the MDS census from CMS.** (SimpleAnalyzer subscribers are all set!)



## **Linking SimplePBJ in iQIES**

(SimplePBJ Subscribers Only)

Nursing homes that are not already linked to SimplePBJ in iQIES will need to be linked for their MDS census to be loaded in SimplePBJ.

- The nursing home's PSO account will need to grant access for Simple accounts
- Each nursing home should have one designated PSO in iQIES, they are often on the corporate, administration, or MDS team
- What to do: keep an eye out for a detailed email from the Simple team and be sure to forward with your nursing home's PSO.




