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

What is iQIES & why does it matter?



What is iQIES (Internet Quality Improvement & Evaluation System)?

- iQIES is an internet-based system that will be used for all submissions and communications to and from CMS starting on 10/1/2025
- This includes HOPE submissions, surveys, and certifications

What is iQIES & why does it matter?



Why the change?

Increased Federal Security Mandates

- Remote Identify Proofing
- Secure identity management provided by CMS through HARP

CMS wants to know who is accessing PHI information

 CMS wants to know what PHI they are accessing and who will be the Provider Security Official (PSO) at your organization

Provider Security Officials (PSOs) Need to Register for an iQIES Account

- Please note that failure to obtain access to iQIES prior to October 1, 2025, will impact your ability to submit HOPE records once the launch is complete. At this time, we are registering PSOs.

Note about CASPER reports and QIES



- Per CMS: Following the 10/01/2025 migration into iQIES, users will continue to access some reports or files in CASPER, including the following:
 - Hospice Review and Correct Report
 - Hospice-Level Quality Measure Report
 - Hospice Patient-Level Quality Measure Report
 - Hospice Provider Preview Reports (November 2025 and February 2026 reports)
 - Hospice CAHPs Provider Preview Reports (November 2025 and February 2026 reports)
 - FY2026 Non-compliance Notification Letter
- *NOTE: CMS plans a phased migration of the Quality Measure (QM) reports from CASPER into iQIES beginning in February 2026. CMS will send additional information to users in early 2026 with those details.






iQIES Registration

Setting up iQIES access is a two-step process





STEP 1 – (HARP)

- Register for a HARP account: <u>https://harp.cms.gov/register</u>
- Setup MFA (Multi-Factor Authentication)
- Complete the Identity Proofing






iQIES Registration

Setting up iQIES access is a two-step process





STEP 2 – (iQIES)

- Log into iQIES using your HARP credentials
- Search by CCN and select the Providers you need access to in the system
- NOTE: Home Health (OASIS Submitters) may already have HARP





Simple: Navigate iQIES with ease



- iQIES access can be time-consuming and requires a complex security verification process
- Simple offers a tool for managing HOPE submissions & reports without going into iQIES
 - Secure/verified CMS vendor Create new users in seconds
 - Simple will request access as an Assessment Submitter (Third-Party)
- We recommend maintaining PSO ownership at the agency/corporate level
 - Consider turnover. Have back up plan.
- 60 Day timeout and access removal policy
 - Set reminder to login to HARP/iQIES at least once every 60 days



A third-party tool like Simple can be very helpful during major regulatory updates like this





HOPE Submissions



Historically, there have been **two paths** for data submission...

PATH 1

Complete assessment and create submission file within the Third-Party Software (EHR)

1. Create file (batch) and submit via the EHR or other submission tool

- OR -

2. Create file (batch), download and then manually upload to CMS portal for submission

PATH 2

Generate submission file on CMS website using the HART tool and submit to CMS

Previously this has been an option for HIS data, but CMS is not continuing HART for HOPE data

For agencies using HART, a new solution will be needed for HOPE submissions

***Regardless of how you submit HIS data, every agency needs at least one HARP account / PSO user for HOPE

How do I prepare for iQIES?



HARP/iQIES account setup for Provider Security Officials (PSOs) is officially open

- Account creation for other user types will be available later once announced by CMS
- Every provider needs at least one PSO account in iQIES

Potential Risks



Turnover Issues

- Selection of PSO (Provider Security Official) is important
 - Corporate Level vs Location Level (or both)
- Consider having more than 1 PSO for each location



CHOW (Change of Ownership)

- Have a well-defined plan (Old Owners access → New Owners access)
- Establish access on or before effective date

Symptom Follow-up Visit (SFV) can be triggered on ADM, HUV 1 or 2:

- SFV is triggered as a follow-up for any pain or non-pain symptom impact rated as moderate or severe on J2051
- SFV requires: an **in-person visit**, within 2 calendar days (can be on the same day as ADM or HUV)
- **SFV is a separate visit from the ADM or HUV imbedded in the assessment NOT A SEPARATE TIMEPOINT
- SFVs items may be completed by either an RN or LPN/LVN

HIS Assessments
For all patients & timepoints

HIS submissions & revisions

TODAY

OCT 1

FEB 15, 2026 *QIES officially closes*

HOPE Assessments

For all new patients & timepoints on or after Oct 1

If a patient is an admitted on the HIS prior to Oct 1, the only HOPE timepoint required is the HOPE-Discharge

HIS to HOPE Transition Timeline



- HIS and HOPE assessments will remain separate in QIES and iQIES (they can't be uploaded or submitted in the same batch)
 - HIS data will always be submitted through QIES
 - HOPE data will always be submitted through iQIES
 - Simple can support both types of submissions through this transition
- If a patient is an admitted on the HIS prior to Oct 1, the only HOPE timepoint required is the HOPE-Discharge
 - The HIS admission data is still submitted after Oct 1 through QIES
- Unless you use a submission tool like Simple plan on managing both QIES and iQIES platforms to ensure all data stays compliant and is submitted on time
 - Simple will keep both HIS and HOPE files organized in a single place for QA/submission







Retirement of HART (Hospice Abstraction Reporting Tool)

How to plan for HOPE compliance







HART is going away... but you have options



- "[CMS] will no longer provide a free tool for standardized data collection. Beginning October 1, 2025, hospices will need to select a private vendor to collect and submit HOPE data to CMS."
 FY 2025 Final Rule (8/6/2024)
- If you use HART for creation of HIS files today OR if your EHR/EMR isn't ready for HOPE on Oct 1... you will need a new method of creating electronic files for HOPE submission
 - Not being able to submit HOPE to CMS can jeopardize reimbursement due to late/missed submissions
- Simple for HART™ is a fillable HOPE form
 - Fill in HOPE assessment fields using on documentation → then Simple converts that information into a file that meets the required CMS specifications for submission
- **Ensure compliance with this CMS mandate through the HOPE transition**




